

2026 Ellis County Air Rifle BB Gun Match

Saturday, March 7, 2026

Air Rifle and BB Gun

Entry form and fees are due by 5:00 pm on Friday, February 27, 2026. Late registration only accepted to fill relays. Relay times will be sent to coordinators depending on the number of entrants. The match will take place at Ellis County Fairgrounds, Unrein Building (BB Gun) Schnek Building (Air Rifle), 1344 Fairground Rd, Hays, KS. Check in details will be provided with the schedule. Timings will be sent out after all registrations are received. Tentatively, check in begins at 8:00 AM. **Each county needs to verify their shooters' information when checking in.**

Fees will be \$15.00 per shooter for Air Rifle and BB Gun per discipline and \$8 per shooter for Air Rifle Silhouette. Please send one entry form per county. Notification of relay times will be given to the contact information on the entry form. This will be a 4-H Kansas State Qualifier for Air Rifle and BB Gun. The match will be conducted following state match rules. The minimum age to PARTICIPATE at the State Match in Air Rifle and BB gun is 9 as of Jan 1, 2026. We do not have a fun shoot for those under age. Age bracket: Juniors 4-H age 9-13, Seniors 4-H age 14-18, BB Gun Seniors 4-H age 12-15 (actual age 15 years old at first shot of the match).

Air Rifle (4-H Ages 9-18): Shooters will shoot 20 shot bulls in each of 3 positions (kneeling, prone, then standing). Flat nose pellets only. Rules will follow the current CMP National Standard 3-Position Air Rifle rulebook. To qualify for the State Match in Air Rifle, the minimum individual score is **450**.

Air Rifle Silhouette (4-H Ages 9-18): Course of fire: 10 chickens at 20 yards and 10 pigs at 30 yards in banks of 5 animals. Targets: 1/10 scale, freestanding metallic silhouettes (Daisy/Crossman type). Rules follow the latest edition of the NRA Rifle Silhouette Rules. All silhouette scoring will award 10 points for a hit and 0 points for a miss

BB Gun (4-H Ages 9-15): Shooters will shoot 10 shot bulls in each of 4 positions (prone, standing, sitting, kneeling). Rules will follow the current NRA BB Gun Rulebook and the Daisy National Match Program. To qualify for the State Match in BB Gun, the minimum individual score is 335. BB gun will be determined by first shot down range (no shooter may be 16 years old by the date of the match).

Awards will be given after the final relay. Must be present to receive award. Individual awards to top 3 shooters in each age classification. Team award to top overall team.
